- Q & A session

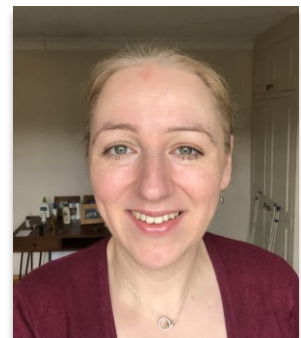
